## Cancellations/No Shows

Students have two attempts at CBEs/EAs. Cancellation ar no shows that occur after exams have been ordered may constitute one attempt.

## Single Subject Acceleration

Single subject acceleration is available only in mathematics, and is provided during the testing windows listed above. Student performance data must be included with the application. Students scaring an 80\% ar higher on the exams are eligible for acceleration. Students only through 8th grade math achieving the required score in Dctober may accelerate immediately; those achieving the required score in March, June, ar July may accelerate in August of the following school year.

## EXAMS FIR ACCELERATION (GRADES 1-8)

Exams far Acceleration (EA) offers students in grades 1-8 the appartunity to advance one grade level by scaring 80\% or higher in each of the four required subject areas. Students desiring to advance one grade level will need the signature of their parent/guardian as well as the building principal or designee. Testing is free for all enrolled SBISD students. Kindergarten students are not eligible for testing until the summer priar to the first grade year.

## Courses required for acceleration:

> Grade Level Social Studies
> Grade Level Science
$>$ Grade Level Math
> Grade Level Language Arts
Math and Sacial Studies exams will be administered first. Fall and spring exams are administered at the student's home campus; summer exams are administered at the SBISD administration building.

## CREDIT BY EXAM*

Credit by Exam (CBE) offers students the opportunity to gain course credit in the subject area(s) being tested. CBEs may be taken with or without prior instruction, and testing is free for all enrolled SBISD students. Fall and spring exams are administered at the student's home campus; summer exams are administered at the SBISD administration building.

When high school course credit is earned through Credit by Exam, the course and the score of the test are posted to the student's transcript. However, the score will not impact the student's Grade Point Average.

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## * Policy EHDC (Legal)

A student may not attempt to earn credit by examination for a specific high school course more than two times.
If a student fails to earn credit by examination for a specific high school course before the beginning of the school year in which the student would ordinarily be required to enroll in that course in accordance with the district's prescribed course sequence, the student must satisfactorily complete the course to receive credit for the course.
